Comprehensive	
<b>\$45 Copay per procedure</b>	Gum disease maintenance and bridge/implants/dentures repairs.
<b>\$95 Copay per procedure</b>	Fillings, non-surgical gum disease treatment, and extractions.
<b>\$595 Copay per procedure</b>	Root canals, bridges, implants, dentures, crowns, and other surgical procedures.

Maximum annual coverage limit – \$1,500 (Preventive, Diagnostic & Comprehensive; excludes copays).

## Additional cleanings

People with certain health conditions may be eligible for up to two additional cleanings and one fluoride treatment per calendar year. Conditions include:

- Cancer therapy
- Gum disease
- Diabetes
- High-risk cardiac conditions
- Weakened immune systems
- Kidney failure or dialysis
